The "Indo-German Urban Mela" consisted of an ensemble of 16 multi-purpose pavilions designed by renowned German installation artist Markus Heinsdorff and travelled to the cities of Mumbai, Bangalore, Chennai, New Delhi and Pune. The pavilions hosted interactive presentations on topics and solutions related to the project's overarching theme "StadtRäume – CitySpaces" and the implications of rapid urbanisation and challenges posed by the pace of change in German and Indian cities today. The participating German corporations and organisations were Bajaj Allianz, BASF, Bosch, Deutsche Bank, Siemens, Airbus, DHL, Herrenknecht, Lanxess, LappIndia, Metro, SAP, Voith, Volkswagen as well as the Indo-German Chamber of Commerce and the Federal Ministries of Education & Research, of Transport, Building & Urban Development and of Economics & Technology.
